II. Academic Excellence

A. Data Update

Christine Beckhusen, the Data and Assessment Coordinator presented DIBELS data comparing Winter 2020 to Winter 2021. After looking at the data, it was explained to the committee that the data collected is skewed due to the fact that the students were remote and not all students were assessed. It was explained that DIBLES data is collected grade wide throughout the lower school and it is collected for students who are at -risk in grades 4-6.

Moving forward the committee would like to discuss in greater details, the interventions that are being put into place for students who may show gaps in their education, due to remote instruction in school year 20-21.

Christine then presented the PELI Data. PELI is the Preschool Early Literacy Indicator. It is given to all students in K1. This measures pre-literacy and oral language skills. The data that was collected in Fall and Winter shows a slight decrease in composite scores.

An update on the student profiles from the subgroups was given.
